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Children start developing their fine motor skills in infancy and continue into their preschool years and beyond. Before children can learn to write they need to build fine motor skills. Many of your child's daily activities—like getting dressed, eating, and writing—require control of small muscles in the hands. These are called fine motor skills. Developing these muscles encourages writing skills as your child gets older. It will also help your child become more independent as they are able to velco, snap, button and zip.

Practice the following to help develop fine motor skills:

- Use Velcro tabs
- Open and close containers with lids
- Cut with child-safe scissors
- Finger paint
- Use a paintbrush
- Play with playdough and clay—roll, smoosh, pat, pound, and use tools like popsicle sticks or stamps
- Draw, scribble, or write with crayons, pencils, and markers
